#### **Police Department:**

##### Action Item(s):

- Approval of a Resolution Authorizing the Police Department to Apply for the Illinois FY 24 Camera Grant Program and Approving the Mayor to Enter into the Award Agreement in an Amount Not to Exceed \$343,229.50

This grant will allow the Edwardsville Police Department (EPD) to purchase body cameras and associated technology to administer the Body Worn Camera Program if awarded. Purchases of the cameras and technology must be purchased first and then apply for the grant for reimbursement.

Motion by Alderman Morrison, second by Alderwoman Miracle for Approval of a Resolution Authorizing the Police Department to Apply for the Illinois FY 24 Camera Grant Program and Approving the Mayor to Enter into the Award Agreement in an Amount Not to Exceed \$343,229.50. Motion carried, Morrison and Miracle voted aye.

- Approval of a Resolution Authorizing the Police Department to Purchase (45) Axon Enterprise, Inc., Body Worn Cameras and Associated Technology for Administering Body Worn Camera Program

The State of Illinois is requiring that all law enforcement agencies within the state have body cameras equipped on all uniformed officers by January 1, 2025. The EPD is requesting to purchase 45 body cameras from Axon Enterprise for the Body Worn Camera Program. The cost will be broken down to five (5) yearly equal payments if Illinois FY 24 Camera Grant Program is not awarded.

Motion by Alderman Morrison, second by Alderwoman Miracle for Approval of a Resolution Authorizing the Police Department to Purchase (45) Axon Enterprise, Inc., Body Worn Cameras and Associated Technology for Administering Body Worn Camera Program. Motion carried, Morrison and Miracle voted aye.

This sole source purchase for Lucas 3 CPR Chest Compression System is part of a replacement scheduled that was established two (2) years ago and will help standardized equipment on each of the ambulances.

**SUMMARY:**

This is a sole source resolution to purchase a Holmatro Extrication Rescue Tools, for a price of \$53,132.00.

**RATIONALE:**

During the response to the December 2021 tornado the Fire Department's Holmatro Extrication tools were used under extreme circumstances which caused damage and excessive wear on the equipment. Subsequently the Amazon Corporation gifted the City of Edwardsville funds to replace these damaged items. This resolution seeks to purchase replacement extrication tools using the funds provided by the Amazon Corporation.

Holmatro is the local distributor of this equipment and the reason for the sole source nature of this request.

**WHEREAS**, Holmatro Extrication tools used during the December 2021 tornado have been damaged and have a shortened life expectancy; and

**WHEREAS**, maintaining our current inventory of extrication equipment is vitally important to operational readiness and ability to handle a variety of emergent situations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Amazon Corporation has provided the City of Edwardsville with funds to replace these damaged tools, and these funds will be used to execute the purchase; and

**WHEREAS**, AEC Fire Inc. located in Springfield, Illinois is the sole vendor for Holmatro Extrication tools in our region and has provided service to the City of Edwardsville in the past; and

**WHEREAS**, the Codified Ordinance, Chapter 254, Purchasing, Paragraph 254.04, (7) authorizes sole source purchases, if such is authorized by two-thirds of the Aldermen holding office.

## STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### 1.ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of Buyer's purchase order is expressly made conditional on Buyer's assent to the terms and conditions set forth herein, which are in lieu of any additional or different terms contained in the Buyer's purchase order or oral statement of Buyer or Seller concerning the Buyer's order or the goods with the exception of fully executed AEC Standard Alarm or AEC Fire Protection agreements. When such agreements exist, they and the language contained supersede the standard terms and conditions. Buyer consents to these terms and conditions by receipt of this acknowledgment without prompt written objection to it or by acceptance of all or any part of the goods and services ordered. As used herein the term "goods" shall mean the materials, supplies, articles, equipment, structures, work, and services furnished by Seller and described on the face hereof, in the attachments, schedules, or other writings connected hereto or by reference made a part hereof.

### 2.PRICE AND PAYMENT

A: Without written mutual agreement for payment terms, progressive draws for monies earned; i.e. engineering and drawings, equipment delivered, labor performed, testing, etc. A 10 % deposit will be due at the signing of the contract. Accumulated billings in the amount of 80% shall be due and payable prior to the functional test. The balance due of 10% is dedicated to the performance of a documented successful functional test, or discharge test, if discharge test is purchased & or required. Upon completion of subject test, a completion certificate shall be submitted with our final invoice. The completion certificate shall be considered as proof of performance on obligations to our purchase contract. Payment is due upon completion of the project, unless a line of credit for the account has been previously established.

B: Buyer is responsible for all, assessments, taxes, duties, and license fees. Interest at the maximum legal rate of 1 1/2% per month (18% per annum), or the maximum amount permitted by changed law whichever is less. Buyer is responsible for return check fees and collection costs associated with necessary collection efforts involved with this agreement including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees. The price of the goods is subject to increase if Buyer delays or interrupts the progress of the work or shipment of the goods, modifies with Seller's consent, the goods or work to be done, or Buyer or its subcontractors request or cause overtime or premium work to be performed by Seller. Labor prices quoted assume a normal 5-day, 40-hour work week and Seller performing the work with its own personnel. Standard labor rates apply. It is the responsibility of the Buyer to notify the Seller if Prevailing Wage applies. Buyer must make notification of Prevailing Wage in writing before accepting proposal from Seller. Special expenses such as installation and rental of telephone facilities, and charges in connection with off-premises alarm connections shall be borne by the Buyer, unless Seller otherwise agrees in writing.

### 3.DELIVERY

Shipment is F.O.B. Seller's plant or point of manufacture and all risk of loss or delays are on Buyer after point of shipment. The time specified for delivery is a desired and not a promised date. In no event shall Seller be liable for loss, damages, or additional costs of transportation, unloading or storage, nor shall the order be subject to termination for default, because of delays arising out of causes reasonable beyond the control of or not contemplated by Seller and/or its subcontractors and suppliers.

### 4.FREE ACCESS

Where Seller is to install, inspect, test, or supervise the installation of the goods, Buyer shall provide Seller free access to all locations required by Seller during installation, inspection, testing, or supervision. Seller's personnel are instructed not to perform any work in hazardous locations until working conditions have been made safe. It will be the responsibility of Buyer to warn Seller's superintendent of any such conditions and to take any measures necessary to eliminate such hazards before work may proceed. Any time lost due to delay in such access or for completion of any preparatory or supplementary work which is the responsibility of Buyer and/or one of its contractors will be charged for as an extra at Seller's prevailing rate.

### 5.BUYER RESPONSIBILITIES

Buyer shall provide electrical power to portable electric tools, sufficient light, elevator service for both personnel and material where required, and reasonable cooperation of its employees. Buyer shall assist Seller's personnel to store tools and materials in locations reasonably convenient to the installation site and not subject to pilferage. In addition, a 120 VAC 15 amp separate circuit must be supplied within ten feet of Seller's control panel. When monitoring is desired owner is responsible for providing and maintaining two secure phone lines to be located within ten feet of the panel installation.

### 6.CANCELLATION

An order once accepted by Owner cannot be cancelled except upon terms agreed to in writing including Sellers cancellation charge.

### 7.APPROVALS

Although Seller engineers its goods generally to meet the requirements of the approving agencies, approval in any specific instance (including this contract) by such agencies and any other third parties is not guaranteed by Seller in view of unusual conditions and individual interpretations which may occur. Accordingly Seller accepts no liability in the event approval of the goods is denied, unless the contrary expressly appears on the proposal and final agreement of which these terms and conditions are a part. Seller shall not be obligated to repair or redecorate due to spoiling of concrete or plaster, installation or piping, conduit, raceways, cylinders, wire or mounting of control equipment or for any other reasons, unless expressly stated in Seller's proposal which becomes part of this final agreement.

### 8.INSTALLATION SPECIFICATIONS

Seller supplies the goods with the understanding that installation will be made either by Seller or in accordance with Seller's specifications.

9.DAMPERING

Unless otherwise specified in the proposal or purchase order of which these terms and conditions are a part, dampering and air control will be the Buyer's responsibility.

10.CONCENTRATION TEST-SUPPRESSION SYSTEMS

A full or partial discharge concentration test will not be made unless specifically included in the proposal or order of which these terms and conditions are a part. To assure sufficient concentration levels in accordance with requirements of the authorities have jurisdiction, tightness of the hazard shall be Buyer's sole responsibility. If additional discharge concentration tests are necessary due to failure of Buyer to assure tightness of the hazard or for any other reason in the control of or the responsibility of Buyer, the expense of such additional tests shall be added to the contract price.

11.INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Seller will furnish copies of general maintenance and operation instruction manuals to Buyer.

12.WARRANTY

Seller does not warrant the goods independent of the manufacturer's warranty. Seller shall replace goods or parts thereof found defective due to improper design or defects in manufacture within the terms of the manufacturer's warranty. Seller's labor cost for performing warranted work within the manufacturer's warranty will be at Seller's cost if the defective goods or parts are reported to Seller in writing within ninety days from date of shipment. After ninety days of shipment, labor performed under manufacturer's warranties shall be billed to Buyer at current labor rates. The manufacturer's warranties are the only warranties applicable to the goods. All other warranties, expressed or implied, including, but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, are disclaimed. Seller makes no warranties for parts parts previously installed by others. Compatibility and or compliance for local authority is not guaranteed unless expressly stated in this agreement. Repair or replacement of goods or parts is limited to the terms and conditions the manufacturer imposes, such as Buyer's assuming the cost of transportation for return, timely written notice of defects, and compliance with manufacturer's conditions regarding care and use of the goods.

13.LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

A.Buyer agrees that Seller's liability whether in contract, in tort, under any warranty, in negligence or otherwise, shall not exceed and buyer's remedy or damages shall be limited to, the return of the amount of the purchase price paid. Under no circumstances shall seller be liable for consequential or special damages. Buyer acknowledges that Seller is not an insurer and that the price stated for the goods is based upon and in consideration of limiting Seller's liability, Buyer assumes responsibility for and agrees to hold Seller harmless from all actions, contract or other duty assumed by or the responsibility of Buyer or any third party engaged by Buyer in connection with goods. Buyer agrees to give the seller prompt notice, confirmed in writing within thirty days of discovery, of all actions, claims, losses, accidents, malfunctions, or damagers arising out of the sale, installation, operation or failure of the goods. Any cause of action arising out of Buyer's order or concerning the goods, whether in contract, tort, or otherwise, must be filed within twelve (12) months after the date of shipment of the goods as evidenced by Seller's invoice or lading receipt.

B.Seller agrees to maintain standard insurance coverage. Any additional insured requirements must be requested in writing and may be provided at an additional charge to the Buyer.

14.GOVERNING LAWS

All questions relating to the validity, interpretation or performance of this contract shall be determined in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

15.RETURNS

Owner must obtain prior approval from Seller when returning products. No returns are permitted on electronics, special order products or articles damaged, worn, or installed by Buyer. Return fees may be applicable.

**ORIGIN:**

**SUMMARY:**

Approval to purchase one (1) 2023 Ford F150 crew cab 4x4 pickup and associated equipment need to prepare the vehicle for emergency response, towing, and hauling. Total cost for vehicle and necessary emergency response equipment including lights, siren, radio and decals is \$63,480.88. This purchase will be funded through the Capital Equipment Fund.

**RATIONALE:**

This purchase is to replace an aging 2008 Ford Explorer XLT 4x4. This vehicle has been scheduled for replacement and is becoming unreliable with frequent break downs, making it no longer safe for emergency responses. The replacement vehicle will be a 2023 Ford F150. This will be purchased using the State of Illinois Department of Central Management Services Joint Purchasing Contract through Morrow Brothers Ford in Greenville, Illinois.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 114 ARTICLE II

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Edwardsville may regulate stop intersections on roadways in accordance with 625 Illinois Compiled Statue 5/11-304; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that it is in the best interests of traffic safety to amend the designation of certain stop intersections;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Edwardsville, Madison County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1: RECITALS.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2: AMENDMENT.** The Codified Ordinances of the City of Edwardsville, Chapter 114 – Stop or Yield Intersections, Section 88 - Designation of Stop Intersections is hereby amended by addition of the following:

- Minnesota Street, eastbound and westbound at its intersection with Banner Street
- Minnesota Street, westbound at its intersection with South Charles Street

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.** Each section and each part of each section of this Codified Ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent section or part of a section, and if any such section or part of a section, or any provision thereof is held to be invalid, the remaining sections or parts of sections shall not be affected thereby.

**SECTION 4: REPEAL.** Any ordinance in conflict with this amendment is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
