The Edwardsville Public Safety Committee meeting was called to order by Alderwoman Janet Stack at 5:31 p.m. in the Governor Edwards Conference Room, 118 Hillsboro Avenue, with a quorum present: Alderwoman Janet Stack, Alderman Chris Farrar and Alderwoman Jennifer Warren.

Public Comment:

- *Complaint of a house on Coventry Place*
A resident on Coventry Place had a complaint about a rundown house and wanted to know if anything can be done about it. The City of Edwardsville is in the process of filing for an administrative search warrant with the Madison County Court and pursuing enforcement action on the property.
