 - B. NEW ITEMS:
 - 1) Resolution approving an Appeal of a Certificate of Appropriateness Denied by the Historic Preservation Commission. Carole Collier Frick spoke. Her contractor, who is not from Edwardsville, started front of house construction in November. This is a late 1800's house. She received a call from Matt Wagner (City Inspector) the week of Thanksgiving informing her of a COA approval before work can continue. This is for siding on three sides of the house. She has lived there for 28 years and her goal is to preserve it to the best of her ability financially. Staff has yet to determine the penalty for the work that was completed without an approved COA. Krause suggests to deny the appeal and levy the fine. – Motion to approve (Krause), seconded (Burns) and voted all nays to forward to Council

- 2) Approval to award the Route 66 Interceptive Center Renovation and Addition Contract to Millennium Construction in the amount of \$378,900. This amount does not include gas pumps or signage including interpretive signage. – Motion to approve (Krause), seconded (Grant) and voted all ayes to forward to Council
- 3) A Resolution Authorizing Great Rivers and Routes Tourism Bureau, on behalf of the City Of Edwardsville, to apply for the Route 66 State of Illinois Grant Round 2. The City Of Edwardsville is seeking grant funds to make critical improvements to two parking lots, which directly serve Route 66 assets: The Route 66 Visitor Center at the historical West End Service Station and the Route 66 Shield Sculpture Pull off Area. – Motion to approve (Krause), seconded (Burns) and voted two ayes and one nay (Krause) to forward to Council
