II. **Council Matters:**

**A. Approval of Minutes from the Public Services Committee meeting of April 13, 2021:**

Alderman Burns made a motion to recommend Approval of the Minutes from the Public Services Committee meeting of March 9, 2021. Alderman Louer seconded the motion. Ayes- Burns, Louer, and No Vote for Morrison. Committee forwarded to Council for information.

**B. Approval of Professional Services Agreement with Oates Associates, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$99,680 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Improvements Project**

Alderman Burns made a motion to approve with Alderman Louer seconding the motion. This is proposed improvements that will consist of a mill and resurfacing, curb and gutter, storm sewer, sidewalks and shared use path, and a new water main from West High St. to St. Louis St. Ayes- Burns, Louer, and No Vote for Morrison. Committee forwarded to Council for consideration.

**C. Approval to award the 2021 Water Main Materials Bid to Schulte Supply, Inc. in the amount of \$42,145.12**

Alderman Burns made a motion to approve with Alderman Louer seconding the motion. Staff explains that this is a water service material bid for 116 water services that are anticipated to be replaced this fiscal year with water main upgrades. Alderman Morrison joined in the middle of the discussion. All Ayes- Burns, Morrison and Louer. Committee forwarded to Council for consideration.

**D. Approval to Reject the bids for the 2021 Pavement Marking Contract**

Alderman Burns made a motion to approve with Alderman Morrison seconding the motion. Staff explains that there are only a handful of companies that bid on contracts like this, but they focus on larger projects and stretches of road. The bid that came back is larger than what was

budgeted. All Ayes- Burns, Morrison and Louer. Committee forwarded to Council for consideration.
