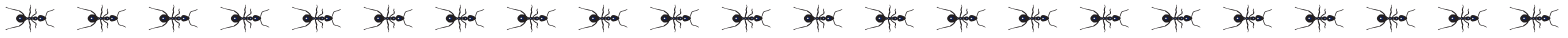
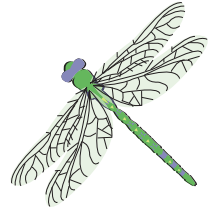


# Building Bugs



# From Nature



## What was your favorite bug?

Inspired by artist **Raku Inoue**, we'll be creating bugs from objects found in your yard.

1. Choose a bug that interests you. Take note of the shapes that make up its body.
2. Walk around your yard and find leaves, flowers, small twigs, or other things that can help build the shape of your bug. **Make sure to ask your parents if it's okay to cut their flowers.**
3. Gather your items:
  1. Yard clippings from outside
  2. Heavy paper
  3. Scissors

4. Begin to compose the shapes of your bug using the materials you found outside.

5. Snap a photo of your creation, print and hang it

\*Optional build: glue your pieces down to hold them in place on a piece of heavy paper or cardboard. When the glue has dried you can brush a coat of mod podge over the top to help preserve your bug.
