**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SIX OF THE  
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EDWARDSVILLE  
(Alcoholic Beverages – Section 6-29. Definitions, Section 6-34. Classification of Licenses;  
fees, and Section 6-46. Closing hours )**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Edwardsville, Illinois is a home rule unit of local government under the Illinois Constitution, 1970, Article VII, Section 6; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(a), of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, the City of Edwardsville may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Edwardsville regulates licensure and sale of alcoholic beverages within the City of Edwardsville; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Edwardsville has reviewed the existing provisions of Chapter Six of the Codified Ordinances of the City relating to the sale of alcohol and has determined it would be in the best interest of the City to amend Chapter Six to create a liquor license class for microbreweries and brew pubs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities deem it to be in the best interest of the City of Edwardsville to amend Chapter Six of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Edwardsville, as set forth below.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Edwardsville, Madison County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1. RECITALS.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** The Codified Ordinances of the City of Edwardsville, Chapter Six – Article II. Alcoholic Liquor Control; Section 6-29. Definitions is hereby amended to add the following definitions:

Growler means a glass jug no larger than a U.S. half gallon (1890 ml) used to transport draft beer brewed at microbreweries and brew pubs, as a means to sell takeout beer.

Microbrewery means a brewery that produces less than 15,000 barrels of beer or ale per license year from malt and hops by infusion, bailing and fermentation.

Brew pub means a microbrewery, as defined herein, that conducts the retail sale of beer brewed on the premises, and other alcoholic beverages not brewed or manufactured on the premises, in conjunction with the operation of a restaurant on the premises.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. The Codified Ordinances of the City of Edwardsville, Chapter Six- Article II. Alcoholic Liquor Control; Section 6-34. Classification of licenses; fees; bonds. is hereby amended to add the following:

(7) Class G1 licenses. Class G1 licenses authorize the operation of a microbrewery producing less than 15,000 barrels of beer or ale per license year in compliance with State and Federal licenses authorizing the production, storage and distribution of an alcoholic beverage. A Class G1 (microbrewery) license shall also authorize the retail sale, at a bar or table, of the beer or ale brewed on the premises. As part of a microbrewery tour, the consumption of up to four (4) samples, which do not exceed four (4) fluid ounces per sample, of the beer and ale produced on the premises, may be provided without charge. A Class G1 license also allows the sale of beer or ale dispensed into growlers for consumption off premises, provided the growlers are properly sealed for transport in compliance with State law. The fee for a Class G1 license is \$900.00.

(8) Class G2 licenses. Class G2 (brew pub) licenses authorize the operation of a microbrewery producing less than 15,000 barrels of beer or ale per license along with the retail sale of the beer or ale produced on the premises and the retail sale at a full service bar of alcohol produced off site. As part of a brew pub tour, the consumption of up to four (4) samples, which do not exceed four (4) fluid ounces per sample, of the beer and ale produced on the premises, may be provided without charge. A Class G2 license also allows the sale of beer or ale dispensed into growlers for consumption off premises, provided the growlers are properly sealed for transport in compliance with State law. The fee for a Class G2 license is \$900.00.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. The Codified Ordinances of the City of Edwardsville, Chapter Six- Article II. Alcoholic Liquor Control; Section 6-46. Closing Hours. is amended to add the following:

(a) Closing hours for holders of retail dealer's licenses shall be as follows:

2. Holders of Class B, C, D, G1 and G2 licenses shall not sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor during the following hours:

Monday - Thursday	Between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.
Friday - Sunday	Between the hours of 2:30 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with, or

inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.




